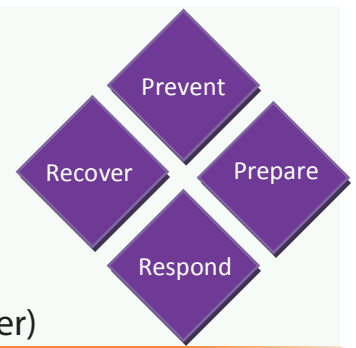

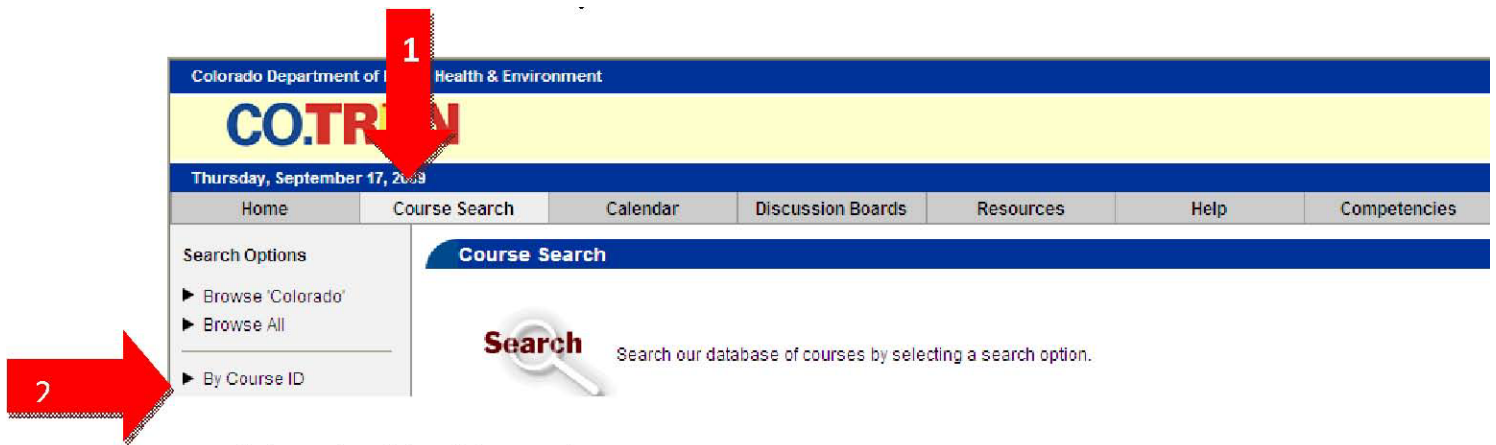

How to Register

There are 2 steps required in this registration process: creating your learner's account and registering for the conference, the whole process will take approximately 5-10 minutes.
